



### DP Liner

Typically an own-root liner in a 2 3/4" band pot. These can go directly into the field or into larger containers.



### Shrub Form

A multi-stem plant that grows this way naturally.



### Pro-Liner®

A 1 gallon container tree, typically own-root material, that is propagated in-house as shift material to finish off a #4 container.



### Tree Form

A shrub that is manipulated to grow in tree form.



### Premium-Liner®

A #4 container shade tree that is well-branched by fall and suitable for retail sales.



### Whip

A bareroot tree with no branching. These are typically a one year tree.



### Multi-Stem

Multiple vertical stems with one root system. These are varieties that naturally grow in the form of a tree.



### Light Branched

Shorter and/or less branches than a branched tree.



### Clump

Three individual trees that are grown separately, but put together to form a clump. These trees have perfectly straight stems and are great for the field or container.



### Branched

A bareroot tree with branching that is evenly spaced and uniform.
